The Berwyns are close at hand, and about 24 Nuttalls! Stunning views,

beautiful countryside and a wealth of wildlife will make for a great meet.

Climbing: Much of the climbing is contained within the Eglwyseg valley. This extends from the Trefor quarry area just behind Dinas Bran castle, to Worlds End, a few miles to the North. The crags are Limestone and whilst there is some quarrying at Trefor, most of the crags are in their natural state. There is a mixture of sport and trad climbing.

MTB: Llangollen and it's surrounding mountains have almost everything for the mountain biker. From canal towpaths, to drovers roads, big climbs, open mountain rides and Llandegla is only 15mins from here.

Cycling: Road cyclists will enjoy a good number of routes around LLangollen with some challenging mountain passes; and on quite roads too.

BEDS: 14+ in various rooms - However we usually reserve a room for the ladies. COST: £40 the weekend, payable on the weekend, plus around £4 for a two course dinner. Bring your own beer or wine (or tea) and don't forget your other food for Fri/Sat and NO sleeping bag is necessary.

STUFF you need to know: These converted 17th-century farm buildings are set in lovely walled gardens with a stream running through. The mountains can be accessed directly from the gardens.

We have booked three cottages which are all linked internally, the centre one being the biggest and with a large inglenook fireplace and group diner.

BEST PUB: Britannia Inn, is situated at the end of the drive.
