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# Edale Meet Peak District Nab View, Ollerbrook Farm, Edale S33 7ZG

Walking. An entertaining 11 mile circular walk combining the old and new routes of the Pennine Way across the famous peat of Kinder Plateau, or how about Ken Wilsons Classic 18miler - a complete traverse of the edges that surround the Kinder Scout plateau. All from the door.

**Climbing**: A crag on the north side of Back Tor, similar to Mam Tor but shorter and much more stable, (more often climbed when frozen) a traditional summer grade of VDiff has been previously suggested although those expecting to employ traditional climbing techniques during its ascent may be disappointed.

**MTB:** 18 ml/3500ft ascent: a classic loop containing the "must do" trails of Rushup Edge, Roych Clough and Jacob's Ladder. Don't let the distance make you think this is an easy route! There is a lot of climbing on it. The terrain is typical Peak District and is ridable all year round.

BEDS: 18 in rooms of 6 x3 and don't forget your sleeping bag. COST: £40 for the weekend + £3/£4 for group meal unless we go to the pub. Bring your own beer or wine (free tea) and don't forget your <u>other food for Fri/Sat</u>. STUFF you need to know: High standard accommodation in a recently converted 18th century barn. Situated on Ollerbrook Farm, it's a beautiful conversion that provides comfortable and spacious accommodation well equipped with cookers, showers, loos, central heating. Good drying facilities, own car-park and is an excellent place to relax and enjoy the best of the Peak District. BEST PUB : Nags Head, 7 min walk, offers real ales and meals. We'll be in here Friday evening to start the weekend off.
